Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

South Dakota Public Utilities Commission Docket No. GE20-002 was opened in 2020 to allow the creation of regulatory assets for potential recovery of COVID-19 related impacts. Pursuant to Ordering Clauses 4 and 5 of the Commission's Order Granting Joint Request for Deferred Accounting Treatment of the Financial Effects of COVID-19 and Creation of Regulatory Assets, Petitioners are required to provide, on a quarterly basis, updates regarding all known and estimated costs it plans to include in its regulatory asset, as well as customer impact numbers related to the pandemic.

On July 26, 2021, MidAmerican Energy Company ("MidAmerican" or "Company") filed its quarterly report that stated the Company did not record any 2020 costs to a regulator asset and determined not to file a regulatory asset in South Dakota. MidAmerican has no plans to seek recovery of expenses related to COVID-19 at this time. Should such an occasion occur in the future, MidAmerican would seek guidance and approval from the Commission at the appropriate time.

MidAmerican respectfully requests the Commission allow the Company to withdraw from Docket No. GE20-002 and cease the quarterly reporting requirements.
