Response:

Although we have been tracking expenses and other financial impacts related to COVID-19 across our entire business, we reiterate that we believe it is premature to report preliminary known or estimated costs or savings. As we track and prepare to analyze the financial impacts related to COVID-19, we intend to evaluate only those impacts that are directly related to COVID-19 or governmental actions stemming from the pandemic.

Rather than provide a preliminary list of potential financial impacts caused by COVID-19 at this time, which likely would be incomplete and potentially misleading, we believe it would be more appropriate to provide an update the Commission on

specific tracked costs and other financial impacts related to the pandemic once data is available, potentially third quarter 2020.
