The IMO Committee is made up of the following individuals: Linn Evans, Brian Bird, Crystal Lail, Kimberly Nooney, Sarah Wiltse, Bobbi Schrappe, Marne Jones, Jason Merkel, Darren Nakata, Shannon Heim, Don Redden, Jeanne Vold. The IMO Committee has a lead from each Company. The Black Hills IMO lead is Madeline Macapugay. The IMO lead for NorthWestern is Mike Neiman. The IMO Committee will be meeting the week of January 12, 2026. The focus of the meetings during the week of January 12, 2026 will be to align around key integration goals and objectives. See Highly Confidential Attachment Staff 2.2a and Highly Confidential Attachment 2.2b. r.

- d. The functional work groups have been established, with an initial meeting scheduled during the week of January 19, 2026. As the initial kick-off for the functional work groups meeting is occurring later in January, there are no deliverables at this time.

Reference the following statement made on page 16, lines 12 and 13 of Witness Bird's direct testimony: "After months of strategic discussions, the boards of both companies unanimously approved the Merger Agreement in August 2025."

Note2: Given that the Joint Applicants' directors relied on the presentation materials provided to them to make the decision to enter into the merger agreement, Staff believes the entirety of all of these presentations is relevant to Staff's examination of the proposed transaction. Accordingly, Staff requests these presentations be provided without redactions. To the extent that the Company claims privilege, Staff requests that, consistent with 15-6-26(b)(5) a privilege log be provided that allows Staff to assess the applicability of the privilege. Specifically, Staff requests that every redaction be logged with the following information: Document Reference, Page Reference, General Description of What is Being Redacted, Specific Privilege Being Asserted.]
- d. For each of the Boards of Directors meetings listed in subpart (a), provide an un-redacted copy of any sections of the Boards of Directors meeting minutes related to the proposed merger. [Note: Staff is only seeking board minutes related to the
