In response to the deadline to receive our "Proof of Claim". We received a call from you, (Jim) the afternoon of Sept 18, 2012 stating that we needed to have our "Proof of Claim" signed, notarized, and postmarked that day. I signed, had it notarized and mailed it that day, Sept 18th. We received a letter saying that it was received after the deadline. I talked to you, (Jim) about the letter. I asked the Postmistress why the letter was not postmarked that day. She told me that with the new postal regulations, she cannot hand stamp any mail. It all goes to Bismarck, ND, and with the massive amount of mail that goes through there, it may have just slid through the machine. I also sent it as "registered mail". The postmistress told me that her metering machine wasn't working and still doesn't work. She said that any registered mail that comes in after 12:00 noon, will be postmarked for the next day instead of that day.
