This memorandum contains all findings by the undersigned examiner during the examination with the cut-off date noted above. Examiner comments are shown in *italic* below each item.

Item no: 1010 Failure to obtain a grain buyer license.

refer to: SDCL 49-45-1

Failure to obtain a grain buyer license prior to operating as a grain dealer. Grain buyer's license required--Violation as misdemeanor-- Injunction--Civil fine. Before transacting the business of a grain buyer in this state, a person shall obtain a grain buyer license from the commission. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor. Each purchase of grain without a license is a separate offense.

Operation as a grain buyer without a license may be enjoined upon complaint of the commission. In addition, the commission may assess a civil fine against an unlicensed grain buyer in the amount of one thousand dollars for each purchase of grain up to a maximum fine of twenty thousand dollars.

Item no: 1015 Failure to obtain a grain buyer bond

refer to: SDCL 49-45-9

Bond requirements--Violation as misdemeanor--Amount. Before any grain buyer license is issued by the commission, the applicant shall file with the commission a bond conditioned to secure the faithful performance of the applicant's obligations as a grain buyer and full and unreserved compliance with the laws of this state and the rules of the commission, relating to the purchase of grain by the grain buyer. The bond is for the specific purpose of protecting persons selling grain to the grain buyer. However, the bond may not benefit any person entering into a voluntary credit sale with a grain buyer. Any person who does business as a grain buyer without a bond is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. Each day a person conducts the business of a grain buyer without a bond is a separate offense.

West Plains LLC completed their license renewal for the 2021-2022 licensing period on August 27, 2021. Leaving West Plains LLC Batesland, SD location unlicensed from July 1, 2021 to August 26, 2021. From July 1, 2021 to August 26, 2021; 123 scale tickets were issued for winter wheat at the Batesland, SD location. While conducting a remote inspection it was noted that all 123 loads delivered had full or partial settlement made on them prior to August 27, 2021. Several of these loads were settled by placement on deferred payment contracts prior to August 27, 2021.
