On February 3, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission staff (Staff) filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a petition to Suspend the Grain Buyer License pursuant to SDCL 49-45-16 and to seek receivership pursuant to SDCL 49-45-16.1 of Roslyn Elevator, Roslyn, South Dakota (Roslyn). The filing stems from a change in Roslyn's financial position and resulting acts of insolvency that require immediate action. On February 15, 2022, the Commission issued an Order Suspending Grain Buyer License; Order to Apply to the Circuit Court to Appoint a Receiver.

On February 10, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. On June 1, 2022, Roslyn submitted a complete application for a FY23 grain buyer license. On June 7, 2022, staff filed it Memorandum with a recommendation to the Commission. On June 27, 28, and 29, 2022, Roslyn Elevator filed financial information in the docket.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant SDCL Chapters 49-45 and 49-43 and ARSD chapters 20:10:11 and 20:10:12.

At an ad hoc commission meeting on June 29, 2022, the Commission considered this matter. Having thoroughly reviewed the filings in the docket and after making further inquiry of the party, the Commission voted unanimously to grant to Roslyn Elevator a FY23 Class A grain buyer and a FY23 grain warehouse license based upon the following conditions:

1. Roslyn Elevator shall not enter into VCS contracts.
2. Roslyn Elevator shall not enter into delayed price contracts.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that Roslyn Elevator is hereby granted a FY23 Class A grain buyer license and a FY23 grain warehouse license subject to the aforementioned conditions.
