**ORDER SUSPENDING
GRAIN BUYER LICENSE;
ORDER TO APPLY TO THE
CIRCUIT COURT TO
APPOINT A RECEIVER**

On February 3, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission staff (Staff) filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) a Petition to Suspend Roslyn Elevator's Grain Buyers License and Seek Receivership. The filing stems from a change in Roslyn's financial position and resulting acts of insolvency that require immediate action.

On February 10, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant SDCL Chapters 49-45-16 and SDCL 49-45-16.1.

At its ad hoc meeting on February 10, 2022, the Commission considered this matter. Having thoroughly reviewed the filings in the docket and after making further inquiry of the party, the Commission voted unanimously to suspend Roslyn Elevator's grain buyer license; allow purchases to be made under PUC staff's direction for the purpose of blending grain; and authorize staff to apply to circuit court for receivership if needed. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the grain buyer license of Roslyn Elevator is hereby suspended; it is further

ORDERED, that Staff shall oversee any purchases made by Roslyn Elevator for the purpose of blending grain; it is further

ORDERED, that Staff may apply to the circuit court to appoint a receiver if necessary.
