On April 22, 2025, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement and Request for Adoption of Settlement Agreement between staff and All Star Trading, Inc (All Star). In this uncontested matter, All Star admitted to purchasing grain in the State of South Dakota without a license and failure to timely provide responses to data requests. Staff and All Star worked together to come to an agreement as to the appropriate penalty and requested the Commission approve the agreement and assess a civil penalty of \$11,000 against All Star.

On April 24, 2025, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-45, specifically, SDCL 49-45-1 and SDCL 49-45-26.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of May 8, 2025, the Commission considered this matter. Having thoroughly reviewed the filings in the docket and after making further inquiry of the parties, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the Stipulation and assess a \$11,000 civil penalty against All Star for violations of SDCL 49-45-1 and SDCL 49-45-26. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Stipulation is hereby adopted and shall be incorporated by reference into this Order the same as if it had been set forth in its entirety herein. It is further

ORDERED, that All Star shall pay a civil fine of \$11,000 within 30 days of receipt of this Order Adopting Stipulation and Assessing Penalty.
