This letter is for the formal hearing
on Dec 3 2007.

I am opposed to TransCanada's proposed
pipeline project. The pipeline will come
within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile of my residence. The underground
water level in our area is high. My well
pit is 4 feet below ground, and every spring
or when we have a lot of rain $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to 2" I
have water up to 1' to 2' feet in my pit.

TransCanada's Pump Station for the
Carpenter area was going to be put on
our land south of Carpenter. We would
not agree to the way they wanted it,
so they went $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south on another person's
land. This land has no accessible road
to it. ~~How~~ How will they get to it in
the winter?

I believe we need more time
to study TransCanada's proposed pipeline.
