This is in response to your letter to the Public Utilities Commission regarding the proposed SCS Carbon Transport LLC CO<sub>2</sub> Pipeline, docket [HP22-001](#).

The commission received a siting permit application for this pipeline project on Feb. 7, 2022, resulting in the opening of this docket. The docket is receiving a detailed review of the proposed project by the commission. This began with public input meetings hosted by the commission along the pipeline's route as required by law.

You will learn more as further project information is being requested by the commissioners and staff, filed in the online docket, and publicly available during the months ahead. I encourage you and your members to follow this docket as it is processed and new information is posted in the docket. Many issues will be addressed by commission staff working with other state agencies and industry expert witnesses.
