pipeline happens to explode. This particular route also goes thru a old farm sight  
that may one day have a home and other buildings. Commissioners, I don't have the insight of  
what may happen 30 to 40 years down the road so I have to rely on your judgement for making  
sure you protect the people of South Dakota and the rights of Stewarts of the land.
