Regarding the CO2 Pipeline Approval for Navigator and Summit Carbon Solutions: I don't think Eminent Domain is part of the PUC's scope in this matter; but if it is, Navigator is a Private Enterprise; CO2 is not a 'public good'.

- -they are taking a safe material (co2) and making it unsafe.
- -2,200 hundred lbs psi on a pipe that is the same thickness as one used for natural gas or petroleum (700-900 psi); .51 inch.
- -24 inch pipe buried 4 ft; indicates the top of the pipe is only 3 ft underground. A 4WD tractor driving over this sounds very dangerous to me.
