Thank you, Mr. Nelson, for your letter dated December 19 in response to my letter dated December 7. I received it today. I appreciate the fact that the PUC called several public meetings for input in regard to both SCS and Navigator CO2 pipelines.

In your letter paragraph 1 line 2 you reference Navigator Heartland Greenway, LLC Pipeline and also on page 2 line 1 you reference Navigator, for a total of two separate times. Nowhere in my letter did I reference Navigator, except the last paragraph of the ADDENDUM, and then only by the one word "...and Navigator..."

Everywhere else in my letter I referred Summit Carbon Solutions as follows:

- 1) in the Re: Summit Carbon Solutions [SCS] CO2 Pipeline
- 2) page 2 lines 4 & 8 "...SCS . . . SCS..."
- 3) last paragraph of the ADDENDUM "...Summit Carbon Solutions and Navigator..."

To me it seems that my letter may have been filed <u>incorrectly</u> in the Navigator docket, instead of being filed in the SCS docket where it should have been filed. Please correct the filing error. Thanks in advance.

I was planning to send another letter to PUC in reference to Navigator <u>after</u> I had more information about their easement contract.

Yes, I knew from your handout that you are not involved in eminent domain or easements, nor planning nor routing. So I added the **PS** saying that I would be sending letters to our legislators so you would know that I am not expecting you to do anything about either issue. I did send letters to the 2 Representatives and 1 Senator for Lincoln County requesting them to initiate or help promote changes to the eminent domain law.

At the bottom of page 1, I appreciate your mentioning that you "cannot simply refuse to consider such an application."
