Concerns: Maps are poorly displayed. North should be to the top of all Maps posted. I taught Map Reading for 20 years in the Army Reserve. With all my knowledge with many kinds of maps, I had a difficult time helping a landowner figure out where the pipeline would actually be located on their land. Main Highways, Street and Avenues are hard to identify.

Most lay people will not have any idea, as to what they are looking at. This should be a concern for the Commission, Landowners, Farmers, Ranchers, all Citizens in SD that are affected by this pipeline.

North is to the left instead of at the top, South is to the right instead of at the bottom.

A-1 Project Vicinity Map – is satisfactory for an overview of the project.

A-2 Hydrology Aerial Map, A-3 Topographic Map, A-4 Soil Map, A-5 Hydrology Map, and A-6 Cover Map do NOT have section numbers, Street Number, or Avenue numbers.

You can zoom on all however it is very hard to determine where it crosses one's land. A-6 has no city names.

Exhibit C supplemental table indicates that Depth and Setback will exceed 49CFR 195 guidelines. NO where does it state what the setback from Homes, Hospital, and Schools will be. It does state a depth of 60 inches (5ft.) cover.

Could NOT find anything on environmental issues.

Could NOT find any information on Landowners Easement Process and Landowner Negotiations on Depth and Setback across their land.
