> Dear PUC Commissioners,

> I am writing to encourage you to NOT approve the CO2 pipelines in S.D. After listening to the many hours of testimony at the Navigator Pipeline hearings I have come to the following conclusions.

> (1) The confiscation of private land using eminent domain to benefit private companies should not be legal. Listening to the testimony by landowners highlighted that they would be forced to sacrifice their rights, property, financial security, and SAFETY.

> (2) Navigators refusal to release their plume model is very concerning. Why are we not entitled to know how much danger this pipeline presents to citizens of S.D.? This is especially important for the high populated areas it's route is planning to cross. I shop frequently in Sioux Falls and if this pipeline is approved my friends and I will definitely reassess where we do our shopping.

> (3) It appears that the rush for this project has more to do with securing tax dollars for the CO2 companies and less about the safest and least intrusive way to capture and sequester CO2. Why put the safety and financial welfare of S.D. citizens at risk when technology provides that this process can occur at ethanol plants, making long, hazardous pipelines unnecessary? This is a project not worth the risks!
