[REDACTED] Comments: Safety issues- approved safety regulations will not be released until 2024. The proposed pipeline is located too close in proximity to existing home and structures, and a proposed building site. The mapping location of the pipeline will pass through the middle of the farm which we find unacceptable. Our farm has waterways, natural springs, steep bluffs, and possible Indian burial sites that would be affected by this pipeline. A September 29 letter from Heartland stated we were not in the direct survey area at the time. Subsequently, we were given a map at the PUC meeting Nov. 29, that indicates the pipeline will pass through over a mile of our farm. We recently received a packet of documents from Heartland which included another map of the pipeline location that terminates in the middle of a field. We strongly feel that Heartland is rushing this project and providing incomplete and sloppy information for a project of this size.
