This is in response to your email to the Public Utilities Commission regarding the proposed Navigator Heartland Greenway, LLC's CO<sub>2</sub> pipeline, docket [HP22-002](#).

This docket was on today's commission meeting agenda, and Navigator informed the commission that certain landowners did not receive notice prior to the Nov. 21-22 public input meetings. This matter was brought up during the meeting by the applicant's attorney, James Moore. He provided the applicant's proposed action and communication with this group of landowners as a result.
