New Businesses and Workforce

- Unemployment rate: 3.4%
- Vermillion is the fourth fastest growing community in the state, and is second only to Sioux Falls in the eastern part of South Dakota.
- Hartford Steak Co. Tavern kitchen staff and servers.
- First Dakota National Bank 10 full-time and 4 part-time employees.
- Dakota Brick House 2 managers, variety of kitchen staff, bartenders and servers.
- Cricket Wireless 3 full-time employees (2 staff and 1 manager).
- Bru2 2 managers, variety of kitchen staff and servers.
- UPS Store 1 full-time employee and 1 part-time employee.
- Vermillion Parks and Rec 5 full-time employees and 80-100 seasonal/temp employees.
- Erickson Solutions Group changed from 2 full-time and 2 part-time to 3 full-time and 2 part-times employees.
- Knutson Family Dentistry 11 full-time employees and 1 part-time employee.
- Fyzical Therapy & Balance Centers 4 full-time employees and 1 part-time employee.

Business Growth

- VCDC hired 3 new full time employees and 2 interns in addition to the current full time staff of 5 and also started construction and renovation of an 1881 building on the Historic Register for future offices.
- Knutson Family Dentistry completed renovation on their current office.

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- Vermillion Area Dance Organization purchased a new studio on Cherry Street that offers more space.
- Sanford Vermillion renovated their building with a total construction cost of \$14.2 million. With the renovation, they are able to provide more space and increase access to more services, including a centralized scheduling and registration area, more clinical exam rooms, outreach rooms, rehabilitation treatment rooms and radiology rooms.
- Vermillion Parks and Rec built a new aquatic facility, named Prentis Plunge in Prentis Park, which replaced an old, leaky pool. The cost of updates to the pool was approximately \$6 million, bringing the entire park renovation to a grand total of about \$6.5 million. Other park renovations included upgrades to infrastructure, removal of some vegetation and updates to the baseball field. The new aquatic center's amenities include a 180' lazy river, lap pool, 2 water slides, a basketball hoop, a one-meter diving tower, shade structures, a zero-depth entry, water features and benches.
- First Dakota National Bank opened a new 16,000 sq. ft. facility on Cherry Street, which
 is adding a UPS Store and Bru2 coffee shop within the facility. It also offers a
 conference room open to the public for meetings, as well as a 2,700 sq. ft. space to
 lease out to prospective businesses.
- Café Brule coffee shop and restaurant opened a smaller version of their shop, named Bru2, which opened inside of the new First Dakota National Bank. It offers the same coffee and food from the Café Brule menu, a sit down area and a drive through window for convenience. The owners of Café Brule also opened a new gastropub in Vermillion, named Dakota Brick House in January 2017 in the building formerly known as Raziel's, which offers a variety craft beers, full menu with high quality food, and music on their outdoor patio.
- **UPS Store** opened a new storefront in Vermillion which offers new shipping and handling options in town.
- Coyote Twin, managed by the Vermillion Downtown Cultural Association reopened their newly renovated auditorium, newly-named RED Steakhouse Auditorium. The new auditorium offers stadium seating, new sound and projection, screen, lighting, and egress. More than \$200,000-worth of donor-funded improvements have been made to the theater.
- Jolley Elementary opened a new STREAM Lab for students. STREAM (Science, Technology, Reading/Writing, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics) education represents an experiential method of learning that encourages children to discover

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that curricular content is interconnected, meaningful and relevant to their existence. The project was made possible by a grant that was awarded to Jolley Elementary totaling over \$99,000 from the state of South Dakota's Classroom Innovation Grant. USD School of Education students will study at the new lab to learn how to incorporate the learning model in their own future classrooms.

- Redwood Mediation Services moved from Sioux Falls into a new location on Main Street in Vermillion with one full-time attorney offering mediation and legal services.
- Fyzical Therapy & Balance Centers formally named Great Plains Therapy, underwent a name chance February 2017 to add specialized services, including vestibular, balance and vertigo therapy.
