**ORDER GRANTING  
INTERVENTION**

**NG19-011**

On December 3, 2019, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Petition for a Waiver of Loss and Unaccounted Calculation for 2020 from South Dakota Intrastate Pipeline Company (SDIP). SDIP makes such request for a waiver in order for SDIP to accurately calculate its Loss and Unaccounted Adjustment Percentage (L&U percentage). SDIP's tariff, as approved on October 30, 2019, in Docket EL17-009, requires SDIP to establish and file for approval of an L&U percentage on an annual basis, with an effective date of January 1.

On December 5, 2019, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of December 12, 2019, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. On December 9, 2019, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) filed a Petition to Intervene. On December 12, 2019, Ring-Neck Energy & Feed, LLC, dba Ring-Neck Energy, LLC (Ring-Neck) filed a Petition to Intervene.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-34A and ARSD 20:10:01:15.02 through 20:10:01:15.05.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on December 20, 2019, the Commission considered this matter. No party objected to the interventions. Finding the Petitions to Intervene demonstrated good cause to grant intervention, the Commission voted unanimously to grant intervention to MDU and Ring-Neck.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Petitions to Intervene of MDU and Ring-Neck are hereby granted.
