The South Dakota Intrastate Pipeline Company ("SDIP") hereby makes and files this Loss and Unaccounted Percentage ("L&U") Compliance Filing. Pursuant to the Settlement Stipulation previously executed by the parties in this docket on or about April 26, 2021, and the Order entered by the Commission on May 5, 2021, SDIP is to make a compliance filing in this docket on or before November 1. SDIP's 2025 leak survey on its pipeline completed on October 6, 2025, determined that leaks do not exist on SDIP's pipeline. Based upon the Settlement Stipulation which provides that the L&U should remain at 0.14% until the current outstanding deferred balance nears zero, thus requiring a new L&U be established, and based upon information provided by MDU, and SDIP's information, the L&U should remain at 0.14%. In support of this Compliance Filing, SDIP provides the SDIP L&U Tracker received from MDU attached hereto as Exhibit A along with the receipts and deliverable summary from SDIP. SDIP presents the following calculations for the period of September 2024 through August 2025:

Beginning Deferral Balance = 273,353.6 Dth

Total Receipts = 3,031,033 Dth Total Deliveries = 3,031,033 Dth Calculated Test Period L&U = 0
