1.2. After having reduced participation in the 2022 program year, does MDU anticipate having similar challenges this upcoming year? Would MDU propose revising the 2023 budget?

Response:

It is difficult at this time to determine if Montana-Dakota will experience similar challenges in the upcoming year. The Company experienced excellent participation in the programs offered in program year 2021. In program year 2022, the main drivers of lower participation were the new construction furnace programs, which the Company believes to have been partially affected by rising mortgage interest rates. The Company also has experienced challenges identifying commercial customers that are looking to invest in energy savings programs though the customer efficiency program. After internal discussion, the Company is open to revising the 2023 budget as follows:
