PUC STAFF'S REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL WAIVER OF CERTAIN CODE REQUIREMENTS IDENTIFIED IN PHMSA AMENDMENT 192-128

ORDER GRANTING WAIVER OF 49 CFR 192.1009

PS21-002

On May 18, 2021, PUC staff filed a letter requesting an additional waiver of certain code requirements identified in Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) Amendment 192-128. The requested waiver is in addition to those granted by the Commission in Docket PS21-001. The waiver requested in this docket is for 49 CFR 192.1009.

On May 20, 2021, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. The notice stated that initial comments were due May 24, 2021. No comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34B, specifically 49-34B-24. At its regularly scheduled meeting on May 25, 2021, the Commission considered this matter. Finding that Staff's request was reasonable and consistent with the PHMSA Amendment, the Commission voted unanimously to grant a waiver of 49 CFR 192.1009. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Staff's request for a waiver of 49 CFR 192.1009 is hereby granted.
