Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) thanks you for this opportunity to provide comments on the rule making and development regarding Stray Voltage in the State of South Dakota.

1. We would suggest that the "Testing Sequence" be revised to a 24 hour test or two milking cycles rather than the current proposed 48 hour test sequence reflected in the following sections:
