NORTHERN VALLEY COMMUNICATION'S (NVC) INTRASTATE SWITCHED ACCESS TARIFF AND REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM DEVELOPMENT OF COMPANY SPECIFIC COST-BASED RATES

Dear Mr. Bullard:

Enclosed please find an original and 10 copies of NVC's proposed Intrastate Switched Access Tariff No. 1 submitted by NVC for Commission approval consistent with SDCL 49-31-19. NVC has proposed an effective date of October 1. NVC's tariff filing herein is a concurrence in the rates, terms and conditions of the current LECA Tariff No. 1, with the exception of the switched access rates, which are based on a statewide average in accordance with 20:10:27:12.

By this letter, NVC also petitions the Commission, pursuant to ARSD 20:10:27:11, requesting an exemption from the requirement to develop intrastate switched access rates based on company specific costs.

NVC is a small start-up CLEC currently without any customers. NVC plans to initially operate in the Aberdeen USWC exchange. NVC is currently constructing its network to provide services and plans to initiate its first switched access services in early October. NVC currently has no historical data, as required by 20:10:27:14, to establish company specific cost-based rates. Further, the process of determining company specific cost-based rates world require NVC to predict future customers and usage, the allocated investment and expenses and revenue for an undetermined customer profile. All of which would be very difficult, to impossible, for NVC to do at this time. Furthermore, such estimates would be untiltely to produce accurate results or rates. Requiring cost based rates of NVC would create excessive costs for NVC without any benefit to NVC's customers.

Therefore, NVC asks that the Commission set NVC's initial switched access rates consistent with ARSD 20:10:27:12, which requires an average rate of all South Dekota



cost companies under 100,000 access lines. NVC's adoption of LECA Tariff No. 1 with the current statewide average originating and terminating switched access rates complies with ARSD 20:10:27:12. Also, this request is consistent with the Commission's treatment of other similarly situated CLEC's such as the Commission's recent action on Fiber Comm's Intrastate Access Tariff in Docket TC99-031, wherein the Commission granted a very similar request to NVC's.

NVC's concurrence in the rates, terms and conditions (with the exceptions noted above) of the current LECA Tariff No. 1 is also based on the fact that IXCs and other LECs operating in the state should be very familiar with it. LECA Tariff No. 1 has already been used by the vast majority of local exchange carriers in the state for many years.

NVC respectfully requests that the Commission approve this petition for exemption from the development of company specific cost-based switched access rates consistent with ARSD 20:10:27:11 and that the Commission approve NVC's Tariff No. 1 as filed herein, which contains switched access rates that are consistent with ARSD 20:10:27:12.

ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR WAIVER

On September 13, 1999, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a petition from Northern Valley Communications, LLC (Northern Valley) for approval of its intrastate switched access tariff no. 1 which is concurrent with the rates, arms, and conditions of the current LECA tariff no. 1, with the exception of the switched access rates, which are based upon a statewide average. Additionally, Northern Valley requested an exemption from the requirement to develop intrastate switched access rates based on company specific costs.

On October 7, 1999, the Commission considered Northern Valley's request for approval of its intrastate switched access tariff no. 1 and a waiver from establishing switched access rates based on company specific costs. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-31-18, 49-31-19, and ARSD 20:10:27:11. The Commission voted to grant the petition for exemption from developing company specific cost-based switched access rates pursuant to ARSD 20:10:27:11 and approve Northern Valley's intrastate switched access tariff no. 1 pursuant to ARSD 20:10:27:12. The Commission further ordered that Northern Valley, within three years of the date of this Order, file a petition to continue the exemption granted in this proceeding or file cost-based rates. Commissioners Burg and Nelson voted to grant the petition for exemption as conditioned herein and approve the tariff; Commissioner Schoenfelder abstained. It is therefore

ORDERED, that Northern Valley's petition to be exempt from establishing company specific cost-based switched access rates is granted and its intrastate switched access tariff no. 1 is approved; and it is further

ORDERED, that Northern Valley shall, within three years of the date of this Order, file a petition to continue the exemption granted in this proceeding or file cost-based intrastate switched access rates.
