TO OFFER A DIFFERENT CALLING AREA
THAN THAT WHICH IS PROVIDED BY THE INCUMBENT
LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIER, OWEST

McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc., ("McLeodUSA") submits this application, to provide a different calling area than that which is provided by Quest Corporation ("Quest") and, in support of its application states as follows:

- 1. McLeod Telemanagement, Inc., was originally granted a Certificate of Authority from the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") on October 22, 1996, which was amended and transferred to McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc., ("McLeodUSA") consistent with the Commission Order dated December 5, 1997.
- 2. McLeodUSA provides competitive local exchange services in an area presently served by the incumbent local exchange carrier, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") and Black Hills FiberCom, L.L.C. ("Black Hills") in the community of Rapid City. In order to be competitive, McLeodUSA needs a calling area similar to what Black Hills is offering.
- 3. McLeodUSA proposes to provide free calling (no toll calls) for its sustainers in Rapid City to all other customers, including but not limited to Quest customers, Black Hills customers and McLeodUSA customers in Bells Fourche, Black Hawk, Deadwood, Lead, Piedmont, Hills City, Spearfish, Keystone, St. Onge, Whitewood, Fermosa, Sturgis, West Bells Fourche, Wyoming, and West Spearfish, Wyoming.
- 4. Toll free calling from Rapid City to the Northern Hills area of South Dakota has been a concern for the citizens of Rapid City over the last several years, and McLeodUSA proposes to provide these customers with an alternative to the calling area presently served by Qwest. Attached to the Application, please see Exhibit "A", the Application of Black Hills Fibercom, LLC to Offer A Different Local Calling Area Than That Which is Provided by the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier, U.S. West (now Qwest). McLeodUSA

shares the same concerns as Black Hills expressed in paragraph 45 of its Application. Even though McLeodUSA cannot provide exactly what Black Hills is offering, we need the opportunity to offer the requested calling plan is order to be more competitive with Qwest and Black Hills.

WHEREFORE, McLeodUSA respectfully requests that the Commission enter as Order authorizing McLeodUSA to provide the toll free calling that is different than that presently served by Qwest, the incumbent local exchange carrier.
