



All state and local taxes (i.e., gross receipts tax, sales tax, municipal utilities tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the quoted rates.

2.6 Installation and Termination

Usage charges for all mileage sensitive products are based on the airline distance between the rate centers associated with the originating and terminating points of the call.

The distance between the originating and terminating points is calculated by using the "V" and "H" coordinates of the rate centers, as defined by AT&T in its Tariff No. 10 as filed with the FCC in the following manner:

Step 1 - Obtain the "V" and "H" coordinates for the originating and terminating points of the call.

Step 2 - Obtain the difference between the "V" coordinates. Obtain the Difference between the "H" coordinates.

Step 3 - Square the differences obtained in Step 2.

Step 4 - Add the squares of the "V" difference and "H" difference obtained in Step 3.

Step 5 - Divide the sum of the square obtained in Step 4 by ten (10). Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction results from the division.

Step 6 - Obtain the square root of the whole number obtained in Step 5. Round to the next higher whole number if any fraction is obtained. This is the V&H mileage between the originating and terminating points of the call.

3.4 TELEFYNE's Automated Collect Operator Service

TELEFYNE provides Automated Operator Service. Calls are billed to the Called Party. The Called Party must actively accept charges for the call. A per-call service charge applies to each call, the rate for which varies depending upon the class of the call.

Classes of Calls

Automated Collect Station Calls: are calls which are placed by a customer who dials all of the digits required to route the call and who follows the TELEFYNE system prompts, enabling the Called Party to accept the charges for the call. If the Called Party does not accept the call, the call is terminated and no billing applies.

Automated Collect Person-to-Person Calls: are calls which are placed by a customer who dials all of the digits required to route the call and who follows the TELEFYNE system prompts to place the call on a person-to-person basis (i.e. specify the person to which the call is being placed). The Called Party must accept responsibility for the charges. If the Called Party does not accept the call, the call is terminated and no billing applies.
