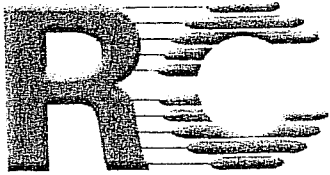

In response to South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (SDPUC) Docket TC05-058, RC Communications, Inc. (RCC) is enclosing the following:

- a revised Lifeline/Link Up application form reflecting the additional eligibility criteria established in FCC 04-87, released April 29, 2004;
- a copy of RCC's promotional materials, including a brochure addressing RCC's tribal lands Lifeline/Link Up offering;
- a copy of RCC's latest Lifeline/Link Up advertisement;
- documents pertaining to RCC's income-based criterion certification procedures; and
- a copy of the verification letter sent to a random sample of RCC's Lifeline participants.

RCC advertises Lifeline/Link Up twice a year in six local newspapers: the Sisseton Courier; the Richland County News Monitor; the Wilmot Enterprise; the Grant County Review; the Britton Journal; and the Sisseton-Wahpeton Oyate. In addition, RCC provides Lifeline/Link Up applications to local government agencies so that those agencies can, in turn, provide them to eligible consumers.
