South Dakota Network, LLC (SDN), respectfully requests the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to grant it a waiver, under ARSD § 20:10:27:02, of the switched access cost study required by ARSD § 20:10:27:07.

ARSD § 20:10:27:07 requires a carrier's carrier to file cost data in support of its switched access service tariff no less than once every three years. ARSD § 20:10:27:02 provides that the Commission may, for good cause shown, either by its own motion or by application from a carrier's carrier, temporarily waive or suspend any rule in chapter 20:10:27.

SDN requests a waiver of the cost study requirement because (1) producing such a study is costly and consumes a great deal of time and resources; and (2) SDN does not anticipate raising access rates at this time, although preliminary analysis indicates that a cost study would likely support higher rates.

WHEREFORE, SDN submits that it has provided the Commission with good cause and it respectfully requests the Commission to temporarily waive or suspend the requirement in ARSD § 20:10:27:07 for the current three-year study period.
