
Dear Ms. Dortch and Ms. Majcher:

Pursuant to section 214(e)(2) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and 47 C.F.R. section 54.210, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (SDPUC) has designated James Valley Wireless, LLC (JVW) as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for the Qwest Corporation exchange of Redfield, South Dakota and the entire service areas of James Valley Cooperative Telephone Company (JVCT). The Redfield exchange is located in a non-rural service area. JVCT is a rural incumbent telephone company. JVCT's service areas consist of the following exchanges: Andover and Bristol; Frederick, Hecla, Houghton, Columbia, Claremont, Groton, Ferney, Conde, Turton, Mellette, and Doland. No redefinition of JVCT's services areas was required and JVCT did not object to the designation of JVW as an ETC in JVCT's service areas.

In addition, the SDPUC hereby certifies that JVW will use all federal high cost support only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, consistent with section 254(2) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. This includes High Cost Loop (HCL) support, Local Switching Support (LSS), High Cost Model (HCM) support, and high cost support received pursuant to the purchase of exchanges. With respect to JVW's study area code, JVW has stated that it as not yet applied for a study area code.

Enclosed is the SDPUC's Order granting ETC designation and certification to JWV. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us for further information.
