There are a total of 23 counties that Long Lines is requesting ETC designation for yet 10 of those counties (Harding, Perkins, Butte, Haakon, Jackson, Bennett, Shannon, Fall River, Custer, and Bon Homme) are not currently served by Long Lines nor are there plans to serve them in Long Lines' 2 year build out plan. When does Long Lines anticipate it will build out into those 10 counties? See Exhibit B to Initial Data Response dated December 15, 2006.

3. The following is language that the Commission approved in prior ETC dockets regarding its jurisdiction for resolving complaints:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this agreement, the terms of this agreement are

subject to the jurisdiction of the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission for the purpose of resolving any complaints and/or disputes regarding service quality and billing related matters. For all such matters, subscribers may choose to bring a complaint before the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission or be subject to mandatory arbitration.

4. Please submit advertisement materials that Long Lines plans to use to inform consumers of its universal service offerings. Included in these advertising plans and materials shall be the advertising plans and materials regarding the Lifeline and Link-up programs and the forms for applying for Lifeline and Link-Up in South Dakota.

5. Please update 2 year plan and include an explanation for any forecasted build out that did not occur.

6. The dockets that you may want to review are TC06-077; TC04-213.

7. The latest wireless ETC was heard on October 31, 2006. Start about 20 minutes into the meeting.

8. Are you asking for redefinition of any service areas? If so, which ones?

9.
