

Those subsequent emails do not provide written clarifications on any of the issues or defenses raised in this matter. It is my understanding from the information provided, counsel for Kennebec also provided to Mr. Wieczorek a summary of a conversation she had with Sean Simpson in March 2008, wherein she reflects she provided various information regarding questions raised by Alltel. Even after reviewing that summary, additional information is needed through discovery to clarify the defenses raised in this case.
