**STIPULATION FOR
SCHEDULING ORDER**

COME NOW OrbitCom, Inc. (“OrbitCom”), MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services and Teleconnect Long Distance Services & Systems Company d/b/a Telecom*USA (“Verizon”), by and through their undersigned counsel, and jointly submit this Stipulation for Scheduling Order to the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”).

PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

1. Parties must initiate discovery by June 12, 2009. All responses are due within two weeks after discovery is served.
2. Discovery requests and responses shall not be filed with the Commission unless necessary in connection with a motion to compel or if introduced as a hearing exhibit.
3. On or before July 17, 2009, OrbitCom may serve and file direct testimony, including exhibits;
4. On or before August 7, 2009, Verizon may serve and file its reply testimony, including exhibits.
5. On or before August 21, 2009, OrbitCom may serve and filed its rebuttal testimony, including exhibits.
6. No witness shall be allowed to testify at the hearing unless that witness has prefiled testimony pursuant to this procedural schedule.

7. Exhibits offered through a Party's witness shall be attached to prefiled testimony.

8. Documents served or filed are served on the date they are received. All documents shall be served by e-mail, in .pdf format or, in the case of work sheets, spread sheets or cost calculations, in the document's original electronic format. Service by e-mail is effective when received.

9. Any and all pre-hearing motions, including discovery motions, shall be filed in a timely manner so as to be heard at one of the Commission's regularly scheduled meetings in July or August 2009.

10. The hearing shall be held on September 9, 2009, in the State Capitol Building, Pierre, South Dakota. The hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. CDT. Parties shall arrive prior to the commencement of the hearing to mark exhibits.


