COME NOW all parties to the above captioned case, by and through their undersigned counsel, and jointly submit this Stipulation to waive and extend the suspension period in SDCL 49-31-12.4(5). Specifically, the parties agree:


- 1) On March 18, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received from Aventure Communication Technology, LLC dba Aventure Communications (Aventure) a request for approval of its Switched Access Services Tariff No. 3 to be effective March 18, 2011.
- 2) At its April 19, 2011, meeting, the Commission granted intervention to Verizon, Midcontinent, Qwest, AT&T, and Sprint.
- 3) The Commission also, pursuant to SDCL 49-31-12.4(2), suspended the proposed tariff for 120 days beyond the proposed effective date pending an investigation.
- 4) Pursuant to the same statute, the Commission may extend the period an additional sixty days for a total suspension period of 180 days. All parties to this proceeding agree, due to parallel proceedings in front of the Iowa Utility Board, to the additional sixty day extension.
- 5) In addition, all parties to this proceeding agree to extend the proceeding for an additional sixty days beyond what is contemplated by SDCL 49-31-12.4(2).
- 6) Aventure Communications agrees to waive SDCL 49-31-12.4(5) and suspend operation of its proposed tariff for 240 days from March 18, 2011 pending a Commission hearing to resolve all issues.






