Dear Scott:

On February 6, 2013, Sprint electronically served supplemental discovery requests on NAT. Previously, the parties had been producing on a 15-day response schedule, but even under the 30-day rule, NAT's responses are overdue. As of today we have seen nothing from NAT. Please provide NAT's responses immediately.

On February 25, 2013, Phil Schenkenberg wrote you in response to NAT's second supplemental discovery responses. Mr. Schenkenberg identified two issues that NAT did not adequately address. To date we have received no response from NAT, which should be easy to provide.

If NAT does not provide its response to those two requests by Monday, March 18, 2013, Sprint will put in for hearing before the Commission at the earliest possible time its motion to compel.
