Below are our responses to your data request.

- 1-1) Attached with this letter is verification that Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company received its ETC certification from Nebraska for 2013.
- 1-2) Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company has 10 customers in South Dakota, one of which is us. They are located in or near North Bristow.
- 1-3) Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company serves all customers within our exchange boundary who request service.
- 1-4) Currently Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company has fiber to the node equipment and facilities in South Dakota that allow us to offer our customers there up to 20 megabytes of download speed and up to one megabyte of upload speed. We have plans to replace the remaining copper plant with fiber to the home facility by the fourth quarter of 2014, which will allow us to offer our customers up to one gigabyte of download and upload speed. We believe this does meet the requirements of the FCC both current and projected since current requirements are four megabyte download speed and one megabyte upload speed, and projected requirements are looking like ten megabyte download speed and three megabyte upload speed.

1-5) If the waivers are granted, Northeast Nebraska Telephone Company is willing to submit verification from the Nebraska Public Service Commission as soon as a decision is made on certification.
