1-1) Please prove that the rates are within compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's November 18, 2011 Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc. (FCC 11-161).

The new terminating intrastate rates must mirror the Company's interstate rates. The interstate rates must mirror the ILEC rates. This was effective last year.

Effective this year, the ILECs reduced their terminating end office rates by 1/3 of the difference between where they are now and \$0.0007. CenturyLink reduced the Local Switching and CTP rates charged by NAT below.

The new Crow Creek composite rates are **\$0.005523** without Tandem, and **\$0.011325** with Tandem (although the Company has not ever billed the Tandem element).

The individual terminating elements mirror the interstate rates of CenturyLink. The mileage is the same mileage (actually slightly less) than the transport mileage billed by the ILEC that serves the Crow Creek area. So, the billed rates mirror the interstate rates, and NAT applies the same mileage as the ILEC would that serves the same area.
