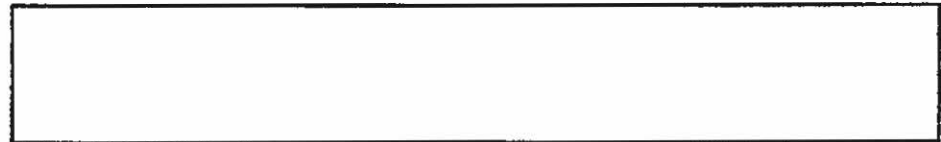

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the Electric Fund, Telephone Fund, Water Fund and Wastewater Fund of Brookings Municipal Utilities, enterprise funds of the City of Brookings, South Dakota, as of December 31, 2014, and the related notes to the financial statements, as listed in the table of contents.
