Answer: Restructuring of the management team was required because the vice president, who oversaw the Denver office where NextGen's deployment is based, resigned for personal reasons. The vice president's resignation left a temporary lack of daily oversight for the project. This situation was corrected by moving responsibilities to others as well as assigning another vice president to oversee the deployment.
