

National Do Not Call Registry

The National Do Not Call Registry has been established to offer you a choice about receiving telemarketing calls at home. Registering will stop most telemarketing calls, but it will not stop calls from certain non-profit and political organizations with which you have established a business relationship. Consumers can register their residential telephone numbers, including wireless numbers, on the National Do Not Call Registry by telephone or by Internet at no cost. The number will be on the Do Not Call List the day after registration, however, telemarketers have up to 31 days to remove the number from their call lists. You may register up to three numbers at one time if registering on the Internet. If registering via telephone, you can register only one number at a time and you must call from the telephone number you are registering. A number can be removed from the Do Not Call Registry at any time. What is Lifeline?

Lifeline is a federal program that lowers the monthly cost of phone or internet service for eligible low-income subscribers.

How do I know if I'm eligible?

To be eligible for Lifeline assistance, you must meet income-based criteria currently defined as at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (see below) OR participate in ONE of the following programs:

- Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Medicaid
- · Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- · Veterans Pension or Survivors Pension Benefit

Lifeline Rules

- If you qualify, your household can get Lifeline for phone or internet service, but not both.
- · If you get Lifeline for phone service, you can get the benefit for one mobile phone or one home phone, but not both.
- · If you get Lifeline for internet service, you can get the benefit for your mobile phone or your home connection, but not both.
- · Your household cannot get Lifeline from more than one phone or internet company.
- · You are only allowed to get one Lifeline benefit per household, not per person. If more than one person in your household gets Lifeline, you are breaking the FCC's rules and will lose your benefit.

Additional Information

- · A household is a group of people who live together and share income and expenses.
- · Lifeline is non-transferable. You cannot give your Lifeline benefit to another person, even if they qualify.
