No. Currently, Midco uses either coaxial cable or fixed wireless to serve customers. Later this year, fiber optic cable will be added.

Aside from the normal ongoing capital expenditures of extending and augmenting the network into additional areas, one of Midco's main expenditures was to begin Fixed Wireless builds in both the Huron and Mitchell areas in 2019.

1-6. In the application filing Midco states it fulfilled all requests for telephone services. Did Midco have any unfulfilled broadband requests in 2019?

There were no unfulfilled broadband requests in 2019 within our service area. We do not track requests outside of our service areas.

1-7. Were any network targets for 2019 not met? If so, explain why.

All network targets were met for 2019.

1-8. Explain how Midco plans to spend the CARES Act funding it is receiving. Provide what projects it will be working on, the locations of the projects, and the number of customers affected.

Projects planned as part of the CARES Act funding include:

- Country Villa- we will be building out our FTTH infrastructure to serve 164 un/underserved homes and businesses in rural Minnehaha County, west of Sioux Falls.
- Belle Fourche East- we will be building out our HFC infrastructure to serve 62 un/underserved homes in a development east of Belle Fourche.
