SDTA Motion to Compel

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen;

SDTA filed a Motion to Compel with the Commission on August 27, 2021. Since that time, LTD produced some of the requested materials. With this correspondence, SDTA now amends its request to the Commission.

Specifically, since filing the Motion:

- LTD provided both the Commission Staff and SDTA with its RDOF application as filed with the FCC. SDTA request 1-1 has been answered and SDTA withdraws its request for a Commission ruling on the same.
- The above referenced RDOF application answers SDTA request 1-10 and SDTA withdraws its request for a Commission ruling on the same.
- The above referenced RDOF application answers SDTA request 1-11 and SDTA withdraws its request for a Commission ruling on the same.

LTD has not, as of the date of this correspondence, provided any information to SDTA regarding the cost to maintain its proposed network. Therefore, SDTA reasserts its position regarding Request 1-12 and 1-13 as contained in its Motion to Compel for all the reasons argued in its supporting brief filed with the Public Utilities Commission on August 27, 2021.
