NOTE 3: Northern Valley has designated the James Valley Cooperative Telephone Company as its Intermediate Access Provider for terminating Feature Group D Interexchange traffic pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 51.914(b)(2). James Valley Cooperative Telephone Company will provide terminating switched access tandem switching and terminating switched access tandem transport services from James Valley's access tandem switch in Groton, South Dakota, to Northern Valley's terminating end office or equivalent for Feature Group D Interexchange traffic.

In accordance with 47 C.F.R. § 51.914(a)(1), Northern Valley will not bill any Interexchange Carrier for terminating switched access tandem switching or terminating switched access transport charges for any Feature Group D Interexchange traffic between the James Valley access tandem switch and Northern Valley's end office. Further, Northern Valley shall assume financial responsibility only for the designated Intermediate Access Provider's charges for terminating Feature Group D Interexchange traffic between the James Valley access tandem switch and Northern Valley's end office.
