On June 14, 2021, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing by Airus, Inc. for approval of revisions to its Access Services Tariff No. 1. The revisions are being made to address the Federal Communications Commission's rules related to Toll-Free Originating Access Service rates. The requested effective date is July 1, 2021.

On June 17, 2021, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 2, 2021, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were received. On July 15, 2021, Airus, Inc. responded to staff's data request and filed revised tariff pages.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on July 22, 2021, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval with an effective date of July 1, 2021. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the above referenced revisions to Airus, Inc.'s Access Service Tariff No. 1 effective as of July 1, 2021. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the above-referenced revisions to Airus, Inc.'s Access Service Tariff No. 1 are hereby approved, effective as of July 1, 2021.
