ORDER APPROVING
AMENDMENT TO
INTERCONNECTION
AGREEMENT

On November 29, 2021, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252 for approval of an ICC VoIP Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Midcontinent Communications.

On December 2, 2021, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. The notice stated that initial comments were due December 20, 2021. No comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

At its December 21, 2021, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Midcontinent Communications. Commission staff recommended approval.

In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement and the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission hereby approves the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC and Midcontinent Communications.
