- 2-1. Refer to the letter filed January 27, 2022 withdrawing the waivers and ARSD 20:10:32:03.11, explain how Celerity will provide customers, under the Certificate of Authority, to emergency services such as 911 and E911.

Response: Any voice services provided by Celerity would be resold services from entities that provide 911 call routing to the appropriate PSAP and E911 services. Celerity would ensure appropriate address information is provided to the entity.

- 2-2. Refer to the response to DR1-7 and the letter filed on January 27, 2022, confirm that Celerity will agree to the conditions that it will not offer any prepaid services including prepaid calling cards and not accept or require any deposits or advance payments without prior approval of the Commission, and be subject to rural safeguards as it pertains to the services under a Certificate of Authority to provide local exchange services.

Response: Celerity agrees to the conditions that it will not provide any pre-paid calling services, including calling cards, and not require deposits or advance payments without obtaining consent from the Commission prior to doing so.

- 2-3. Confirm and provide a brief explanation that Celerity is not seeking Certificate Authority for its VoIP services but only for services where a customer requests a non-VoIP product.

Response: Celerity is only seeking Certificate Authority for local exchange services.
