At the request of Commission Staff, Celerity Networks LLC ("Celerity") provides additional information to clarify portions of its Application in this matter.

In part 18 on page 7 of the Application and in response to Staff Data Request 1-12, Celerity stated it would bill for monthly service one month in advance. Celerity clarifies that it will not bill in advance, request prepayment or collect deposits for local exchange service. If, if the future, Celerity plans to require advance payment for local exchange service, Celerity will provide a performance bond.

In part 23 on page 9 of the Application, Celerity requested waiver of S.D. Admin. Rule 20:10:32:10. Celerity's services will comply with the requirements of S.D. Admin. Rule 20:10:32.10. Accordingly, Celerity withdraws the request for waiver.
