On February 17, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing for Approval of a Reciprocal Transport and Termination Agreement between Brookings Municipal Utilities dba Swiftel Communications (Swiftel) and T-Mobile USA, INC. (T-Mobile). According to the filing, the parties wish to put in place an arrangement for the mutual exchange and reciprocal compensation of local telecommunications traffic between their respective networks in accordance with FCC rules and the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

On February 24, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing of the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. The notice stated that initial comments were due March 9, 2022. No comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-31 and the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

At its March 15, 2022, meeting, the Commission considered whether to approve the negotiated Interconnection Agreement between Swiftel Communications and T-Mobile. Commission staff recommended approval.

In accordance with 47 U.S.C § 252(e)(2), the Commission found that the Interconnection Agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the Interconnection Agreement and the Interconnection Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the Interconnection Agreement. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission hereby approves the Interconnection Agreement between Swiftel Communications and T-Mobile.
