On March 17, 2022, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a Petition for Waiver of ARSD 20:10:32:52 Filing Deadline (Petition) from the South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA). In its Petition, SDTA requests that the Commission waive the June 1 deadline for recertification filings by Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETC) and require ETCs to file their 2023 certification petitions on or before July 1, 2022.

On March 24, 2022, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. The notice stated that any person wishing to comment on the clarification of the ETC certification process had until April 1, 2022, to do so. No comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31, specifically SDCL 49-31-3, 49-31-78, and ARSD 20:10:32:52.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on April 14, 2022, this matter came before the Commission for consideration and action. The Commission voted unanimously to grant a waiver of the June 1 filing deadline found in ARSD 20:10:32:52 and to allow ETCs to file their annual certification petitions on or before July 1, 2022. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the June 1 deadline in ARSD 20:10:32:52 is waived and ETCs shall file their annual certification petitions on or before July 1, 2022.
