On June 30, 2023, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from AT&T Corp. for approval of revisions to its Access Services and Network Interconnection Services Tariff. This filing proposes the next step in implementing the 8YY Access Service reductions mandated in the Federal Communications Commission's October 9, 2020, Report and Order in WC Docket No. 18-156, FCC Release No. 20-143. AT&T Corp. requests an effective date of August 1, 2023.

On July 13, 2023, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of July 21, 2023, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv.
