TC24-009


IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED among Midcontinent Communications ("Midco")  
and James Valley Cooperative Telephone Company, d/b/a James Valley  
Telecommunications ("JVT") that the above captioned matter be dismissed without further  
action of the Commission for reasons as follows:


1. The Extended Area Service (EAS) Agreement previously entered into between  
the parties and effective as of September 1, 2003, expressly stated that the "Parties understand  
and agree that [the EAS Agreement] need not be filed with the Commission" in accordance  
with Commission policy.

2. Wherefore, as the Commission policy has not changed, and therefore any  
amendment to said unrecorded Agreement also need not be filed, the parties jointly stipulate  
that this matter may be dismissed without further action from the Commission.
